To the saints gathered unto the precious Name of our Lord Jesus Christ elsewhere, beloved brethren greetings:

We are at the close of the present dispensation. Indeed, we can echo the Apostle in saying: **“The night is far spent, the day is at hand”** (Rom. 13:12). As with natural things, the darkest hour is often the one before dawn. In the midst of such darkness, however, the stars shine their brightest. One should be filling our hearts as we watch and wait—the Daystar (2 Pet. 1:19). **“I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star”** (Rev. 22:16). Although we may not always account it so, it is our present privilege to wait with Christ as He anticipates that nuptial day. **“The Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patience of the Christ”** (2 Thess. 3:5 JND). We are reminded of another day, a day which also marked the end of a dispensation—we read of it in the early chapters of Matthew and Luke. Lord willing, all meetings will be held at the **Vivos Institute near Denver International Airport**. Accommodation will be at the **Staybridge Suites, Denver International Airport**. These are the same locations which worked so well last year. **Details are provided on the accompanying sheet**. Meetings will begin with prayer at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, September 4, 2026, and continue through Lord's Day, September 6. For those arriving on Friday, supper will be provided from 5:00 to 6:30 p.m. When making your reservation, please indicate if you plan to attend the Friday night supper. **Also, we need to know if you have any dietary restrictions; the facility requires this information in advance**. The first meeting on Saturday, September 5, at 9:30 a.m. will be for prayer. As in the past, an activity will be arranged for those who choose to stay over into Monday, Labor Day, September 7.


Please let us know by August 14 if you plan to be with us. The hotel needs a firm number of guests by this date. **As the facility has a hard maximum capacity, please check availability before making travel arrangements**.
