

# Other Camp and Conference Related Information

## Your First Time at Carrollton?

Camp Muskingum is a Future Farmers of America camp built in the 1940s. The setting is beautiful and there will be opportunities for outdoor games and water activities. You will get some exercise going between the Meeting Room, Dining Hall, dorms, and the lake.

**Please bring appropriate clothing for recreation and lake activities, such as extra shoes, etc. Also remember to bring your Bible, hymn book, and flashlight (if desired).**

The "dorms" are in a barracks style, full of bunk beds. The dorms have been renovated, and each dorm now has air conditioning and both men's and women's restrooms inside the building. For young people, the girls have one complete dorm to themselves, and the boys have another complete dorm to themselves. The family dorms are sectioned off into family-size compartments separated by heavy duty curtains. There is visual privacy but not much auditory privacy (we will gladly make hotels available for those who prefer). **Those staying in the dorms need to bring their own bed linens, blankets or sleeping bags, pillows, towels, soaps, and shampoos.**

There are a few rooms with walls available in the camp that are used primarily for our more senior guests and families with very small children. As mentioned above, hotel accommodations are also available. We want your stay to be pleasant, so please feel free to let us know your preferences.

## Other Items

When using your GPS for directions to the Camp be sure to use the "3266 Dyewood Rd. SW, Carrollton, Ohio 44615" address. The camp has a building on the other side of the Lake. If you only enter "Camp Muskingum" you will probably get more than one address.
